SUBJECT:

PURPOSE:

Other worthwhile duties are operational within the individual, the family, and the social context.

THE GOOD CHARACTER BOOK READING COMPETITION GUIDELINE

- The competition will be held for each school on its own campus. It will be conducted on 1st August at 10 a.m. as it's stipulated in the activity calendar of Ministry of Education.
- Students have to be present latest by 9:45 in their own school campus on that day.
- Students of Grade 8 and above classes are eligible to participate in this competition.
- There will be teachers from Lale Youth International School to provide the exam papers and accompany to your own invigilators. (Due to conducting this contest in many schools we would not be able to provide all invigilators, so you need to provide your own invigilators for the exam. Those teachers who will be coming from our school will be responsible for only distributing and collecting back the exam papers.

- Exams will be held on the school campuses, main halls or any other locations assigned by school managements.
- Schools shall provide the participant lists with a focal contact person from the school side until 4th June, 2015.

EXAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The exam consists of 100 multiple choice questions and the duration is 120 minutes
- Each participant should have a pen; final answers will be written on the answer sheets by only pen those answer sheets written by pencils will not be evaluated.
- All electronic devices are strictly prohibited during the exam.(To avoid causing any distraction and cheat)
- During the exam students are not allowed to go out or accompanied by an invigilator for washroom matters.
- The total duration of the exam is 120 minutes. Even though the participant will complete the exam, he/she is not allowed to leave within the first 30 minutes.
- Scrap papers are not allowed .Blank pages provided on the booklet will be enough.
- Participant should write his/her name on both exam papers and answer sheet.
- Student shall sit alone and keep a certain distance from his/her peers same as Cambridge exams.
- During the exam participants should avoid distracting others attention
- After the exam; Exam booklets and answer sheets shall be collected and delivered to Lale Youth International School by the chief invigilators
